This trip allows PHS students to participate in the Prescott-Zeitz Sister City Exchange Program. There will be 4 PHS students on this trip. They will be staying with host families in Zeitz, Germany, attending daily classes in a Zeitz high school, giving presentations on life in Prescott, and taking day trips to nearby cities to deepen their German language skills, explore German culture, and serve as cultural ambassadors from the Prescott area. Robert Ernst, German Teacher at PHS, and a second PHS teacher (TBD) will serve as chaperons on this trip. Plane flights will be conducted through a local travel agency. The itinerary in Germany is organized by our colleagues in Zeitz. The cost of the plane fare for students will be subsidized by a \$5000 donation from the Prescott-Zeitz Sister City organization, tax credit funds, and funds raised by the German Club at PHS. Room, board, and travel in Germany will be taken care of by the Sister City organization in Zeitz and by the Zeitz host families. The trip is from May 30, 2023, to approximately June 19, 2023.
